

Save the Mothers

Ancaster, Ontario

Its mission is to train local leaders in the developing world to reduce maternal mortality within their own countries. The 256 Youth Platform, an organization in Uganda, creates systems in communities to support preg-



nant girls and the boys responsible for these pregnancies, by employing them within the project and providing them mentorship.

RECIPIENT EXAMPLES

The Working Centre

Kitchener, Ontario

In addition to providing job searches and career counselling, the St. John Soup Kitchen provides a hot meal at noon during weekdays to 200 mostly unsheltered people, along with health care, washrooms, shower, access to laundry, take away snacks and drinking water. At another location 600 meals are prepared each day for those in supportive housing locations and motels.

Doctors Without Borders

Medecins Sans Frontieres

which MSF had interventions
in 2020 saw a substantial increase to more than 85.



Their Impact Report gave the following statistics: 2,690,600 malaria cases treated, 8,300 treated for cholera, 29,300 treated for sexual violence, 349, 500 individual mental health consultations, 15,900 tuberculosis treatment, 306,800 births assisted including Caesarian sections, 64,300 severely malnourished children admitted to inpatient feeding programs.

Eagle's Nest Association of Waterdown

Eagle's Nest has helped people cultivate healthy relationships, navigate trauma, and develop self-worth in the course of their services, counselling, coaching, parenting classes and support groups. HOPE Centre provides youth with certified counsellors and learning tools to manage their emotions and to adapt healthier ways to communicate.
