Nation Unsevered, Tucson, AZ

Advocacy and alllyship for Indigenous people, communities, women and girls throughout North America. *Grant*: Towards the expansion of their Holistic Empowerment and Self-Defense Facilitator training program for Indigenous women called House of the Moon.

The Thomas More Project, Baltimore, MD

Provides tuition assistance to underprivileged children who could not otherwise attend a Catholic school and develops innovative programs to reach children at educational risk.

Grant: Establishment or strengthening of endowment programs at independent women's Catholic schools.

Centro de Intercambio y Solidaridad (CIS), San Salvador, El Salvador

Promotes social justice, human dignity and solidarity among communities in El Salvador and around the world. *Grant*: For their Clean Water and the Environment Program.

MOMCares, Baltimore, MD

Provides doula care to women – especially women of color – who are at risk of a traumatic birth outcome. *Grant*: Towards ongoing services for mothers, including transportation, childcare, advocacy, and self-care opportunities.

Itinerant University of Resistance in Haiti (UNIR), Pacot, Haiti

This university-without-walls, UNIR, helps Haitians – especially women – become effective organizers for women's rights, Earth and climate defense, land rights, democracy, and economic and political justice. *Grant:* Towards a new undergraduate scholarship program and an educational experience for three Haitian women.

St. Monica Women's Group-Rumbek, South Sudan

Community empowerment for internally displaced persons in South Sudan. *Grant:* To purchase new sewing machines and provide stipends for trainers.

St Ambrose Housing Aid Center, Inc., Baltimore, MD

Creates and maintains equal housing opportunities for low- and moderate-income people in and around Baltimore City, and encourages strong and diverse neighborhoods.

Grant: For a two-year subscription to a Learning Management System as well as meeting supplies.
