
# Atlantic-Midwest Province Justice for Immigrants Survey Results



### Thank you for your responses to our survey. Here we share excerpts that may interest you.

We had 94 responses. 76 of those had interacted with immigrants/migrants/asylees/refugees.




When: Of the 76 who have had contact with migrants, over half are currently in contact with migrants.




**Setting**: Over half of the interactions with migrants has been in a ministry setting, 23% in the parish and 36% in the neighborhood. Other ways of interacting include sharing a residence, through friends or organizations, through a house cleaning service, at a school, as a speaker at an event.



**Capacity in which these interactions occurred**: as a fellow parishioner (24%), as a neighbor (34 %), as a volunteer (38%) and as paid staff in ministry (32%). Other roles included: leadership, participant at a solidarity prayer with immigrant family, as a godparent, as a friend, as an audience member at a presentation by a migrant.



**Specific ways of working with or assisting migrants:** 34% ESL, 17% advocacy (contacting gov't agencies, etc.), 25% formal education, 26% tutoring, 23% social service (housing, food pantry, clothing distribution etc.), 14% in pastoral ministry, 8% medical, 3% legal assistance, 3% counseling, 1.5% for general education diploma. Other ways included being a family mentor, working with NGOs at the UN, being a friend, extending hospitality, municipal law enforcement.








### Vehicles used for Advocacy
